Year 6 Residential in October 2019.

For the children going in to Year 6 next year we are running a weekend residential trip. As in previous years, we have decided to go in October so the children can make new friends and get to know their teachers.

We are going to return to PeakVenture, an activity site run by Kingswood.

This is situated in near Sheffield, about 40 miles away from Leeds. If you have access to the internet you can go online to www.kingswood.co.uk or come and see me as I have a DVD that I can lend to you so you can see for yourself where the children will be going.

How much does it cost & how can I pay?

The cost of the trip this year is £80.

The actual cost per child is £140 but we are continuing to use Pupil Premium money to pay for almost half the costs.

A non-refundable deposit of £20 is needed to secure your child a place on the trip. This deposit needs to be paid in an envelope with your child's name on by Friday 1st March.

After that you will be able to pay for the trip using our online cashless system where you can pay as little or as much as you can afford week by week. All you need to do is make sure the full amount is paid two weeks before we go!

When is the Trip and what will they do there?

The date of the trip will be Friday 4th October till Sunday 6th. We will set off from school around 2pm and get back to school on the Sunday around 2.30pm.

When the children arrive they will have a tour of the building, a safety talk, make their beds and unpack their bags and then get straight into the activities.

The activities that the children can experience there are:

Rock Climbing, Abseiling, Zip Wire, Leap of Faith, Fencing, Archery, Camp Fire, Disco and much more!

Bedtime is around 10pm on the Friday and 11pm on the Saturday.

What will they eat?

The children will have 3 meals each day.

Breakfast is served at 8am and the children have a choice of cereals like Cornflakes or Coco Pops or a cooked breakfast with bacon, sausages, egg and toast.

Lunch is a packed lunch. A vegetarian option is always available.

Dinner time is around 5pm and there is plenty of choice. There are meals are similar to those that we have at school on our new menu. Meals such as lasagna, pasta or pizza with vegetarian options available. There is also a healthy option of salads and cooked meats.
