



A guide to our new Behaviour Policy.

The main changes are:

- Children **must** follow the instructions of an adult when it comes to staying safe during lockdown. Instructions might be to:
 - Keep a safe distance from others
 - Not enter a bubble that is not their own
 - Wash their hands regularly
 - Cover their mouth when they cough
 - Cover their nose when they sneeze
 - Not touch another person's equipment.
- Children must not tease or call another child a name based around COVID-19.
- Children will not receive the same amount of warnings that they previously did with regard to these behaviours. This is because they are dangerous in the current situation.

If you can't support the school's application of these rules, then you should not send your child back to school at this time.
