I'm sure you will agree that we are taking big steps in improving the quality of sport in our school, both in terms of opportunities to participate as well as to compete.

We are aiming to provide children with as many opportunities to compete in school as possible and it goes without saying, that we want them to compete professionally and in a respectful manner. As a school we feel we all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in sport.

We have a set of basic guidelines, based on The FA's Respect programme (2014), to ensure sport can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment. Remember children's sport is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything.

- Remember that children play for FUN.
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success.
- Always respect the match officials' decisions.
- Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators' Area (for home football matches this is the green fencing on the field)
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do.
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials.
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake – mistakes are part of learning.
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.

We hope to see lots of you at sporting events to support our children in all events. All your support is appreciated and it has a big impact on the children when they receive the support of our entire school community.
