## WE WILL

- Support the school in insisting that our child follows any instruction from a teacher regarding safety during this time.

- Collect our child on time after school or make arrangements for them to safely walk home alone (Years 5 and 6).
- Support our child where I can with their education, helping them to log on and complete activities such as TT Rockstars or Numbots.
- Stay away from school and inform you as soon as possible if a member of our household has any symptoms of Coronavirus.
- Talk to our child about their life at school, including anything they may be worried about.
- Support the school in insisting that our child tells a member of staff if they are feeling unwell.
