With everything that is happening at the moment and the current situation, I thought it was important that I wrote to you about the planned Year 4 Residential to Eyam.

We had planned for our residential to take place in June of this year but this has now been rearranged for September. **The new dates for our residential are Monday 21<sup>st</sup> September – Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> September.** We will still be using the Eyam Youth Hostel as our base and our planned activities will still take place, these being:

- the famous plague village of Eyam
- the famous Speedwell Cavern – taking a boat trip through the caves
- Walking across one of the Three Peaks and enjoy the countryside in the Peak District
- a visit to Matlock Farm

Even though the children will be in Year 5 when we now go on the residential, the children will still go on the residential with the Year 4 staff that teach them now, so they can get the same experience as we had originally planned for.
