Spare clothes

Water and Juice

We are a water only school. The government states that children should only have water or plain milk in school and that even diluted juice can cause tooth decay.

Dental advice recommends that drinking juice between meals causes even more damage to teeth, so if children bring juice in a water bottle to drink throughout the day, they will be asked to drink water instead.

Hot weather

We play outside rain or shine! As the weather begins to warm up (fingers crossed!), please make sure your child comes to school with a sun hat. Can we please ask that you apply sun cream to your child *before Nursery* on particularly hot days? For children who stay the whole day, we can reapply sun cream in the middle of the day. Please make sure you have given permission on Arbor if you would like your child to use the school sun cream.
