Parent/Carer Survey

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to let you know the results of our recent survey and to let you know what we will be doing to improve further.

The survey, sent out at the start of November, was completed by 133 parents or carers, just under 1/3rd of our families.

The survey used the same questions that Ofsted asks parents and carers when they visit a school to compare the scores we had as a school to the scores of schools across the country.

Overall, the results show that most parents and carers are happy with the school and how we support and teach their children.

For example:

92% of parents and carers think their child is happy at school. 92% of all parents and carers believe their child is happy in school.

95% of parents and carers think their child is safe at school. The national average for this question is 93%.

91% of parents and carers would recommend our school to a friend. Nationally, only 86% of parents/carers would recommend their child's school.

However, there were some areas that the survey showed us we need to work on. The first is communication.

Communication

10% of parents and carers don't know if we have high expectations for children's behaviour, and 15% don't know if we had effectively dealt with Bullying when it occurred to their child.

As well as these scores, 16% of parents and carers don't know if we have high expectations for their child, and 15% didn't know how we develop their children's interests in things other than reading, writing and maths.

This highlights that even though we have platforms such as our website, Twitter, Facebook and half-termly newsletters, we need to do more to tell parents and carers about what is happening in school. After Christmas, you should expect your child's class newsletter to contain more information about what they will be learning over the next six weeks and how we will be developing their interests. You should also expect to see photos of excellent work and presentation, so you can see the high expectations we have for your child.

Bullying

The second area we will focus on between now and Christmas and then into the new year is Bullying.

As a ginger-haired Headteacher who had spots in high school, I know how hurtful Bullying can be, and I am determined that when Bullying occurs in our school, we act quickly to stop it as soon as possible.

When a child or parent/carer makes us aware that they are being bullied, we will:

- Speak to the child who is being bullied
- Speak to the parent/carer of the child who is being bullied letting them know we are dealing with it and to get any information they have
- Speak to the child/children who is/are accused of Bullying
- Speak to the parent/carer of the child who is being accused of Bullying to let them know we are dealing with it and to get any information they have
- Speak to any other children who might be able to give us more information about what has happened

From all the information we have, we will be able to determine if what happened was:

- A one-off event that will be dealt with using the school's Behaviour policy
- Bullying by a person or a group and will be dealt with using the school's Anti-Bullying policy

Whichever one we determine to have happened, we will let everyone know so that in future, when asked if we have dealt with Bullying effectively, parents and carers will be able to say Yes or No rather than Don't Know.

On the next few pages, you will see the results for our school and the national averages.

You will also know that the school was inspected by Ofsted last Tuesday and Wednesday. While we have to wait until the official report comes out at the start of January, we can say that they were blown away by how confident, welcoming and polite your children were to them over the two days. We look forward to sharing the report with you as soon as we can.
