## Individual Photos

In the morning the photographers are in school taking individual and family photos. Children should come into school at the normal time wearing their school uniform (**not** their PE Kit even if it is PE day).

After the register has been taken, each class will visit the hall for the photos to be taken. After all the classes have had their photo taken, we will start getting families to come to the hall.

The oldest child in a family, will go to the different classrooms in school and collect their brothers and sisters and take them to the hall, where they will have a group photo. After the photo has been taken, the oldest child will take their siblings back to the class before returning to their classroom.

If the oldest child in the family is still very young, Year 2 or below, a member of staff will help them collect their younger siblings.

## Meet your Child's Teacher

After school tomorrow, there is the chance to visit the classrooms in Years 1 to 6 to see where your child is learning in school. Their teacher or teachers will be there to introduce themselves to you and to let you know what your child will be learning about this year.

We know that many families have two children at school so there are two meetings. The first is at 3.30 and lasts for around 25 minutes and the second is at 4.05.
