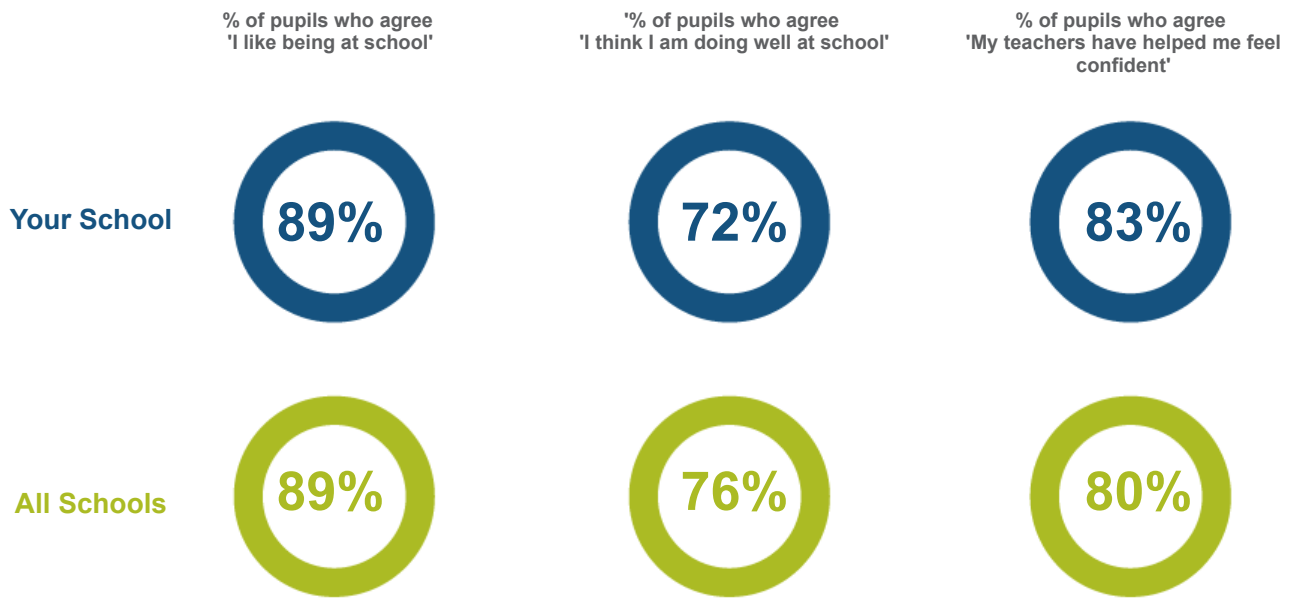

174 pupils completed the NFER pupil survey at your school.

For every question in the survey we have calculated whether there is a significant difference in the rating applied to each statement by your pupils compared to all pupils in the sample weighted to be nationally representative (All Schools).

The three areas where your school is most successful and the three areas where your school is least successful compared to other schools which took part in the pupil survey are shown below.

Areas of strength in your school are:

In my school - My teachers treat all children the same

In my school - My teachers listen to me

It is important to have school rules

Areas of potential development in your school are:

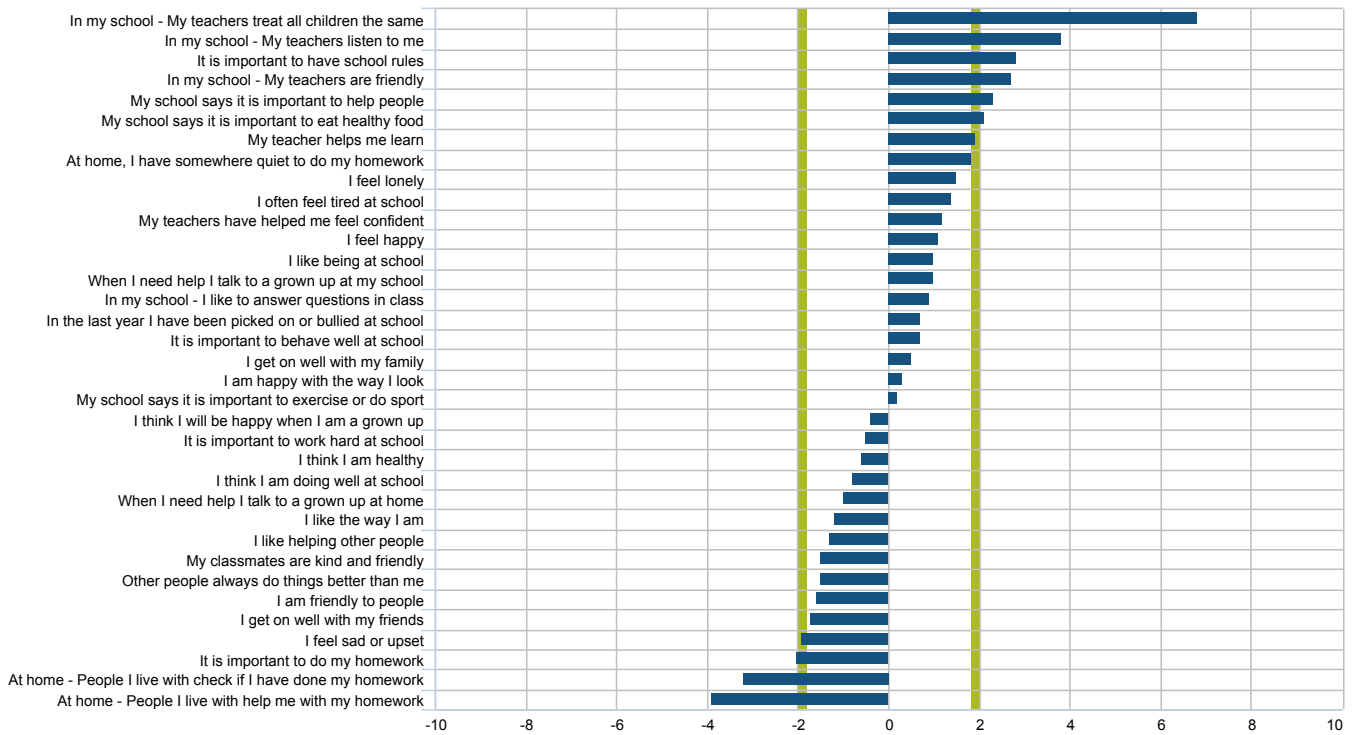
At home - People I live with help me with my homework

It is important to do my homework

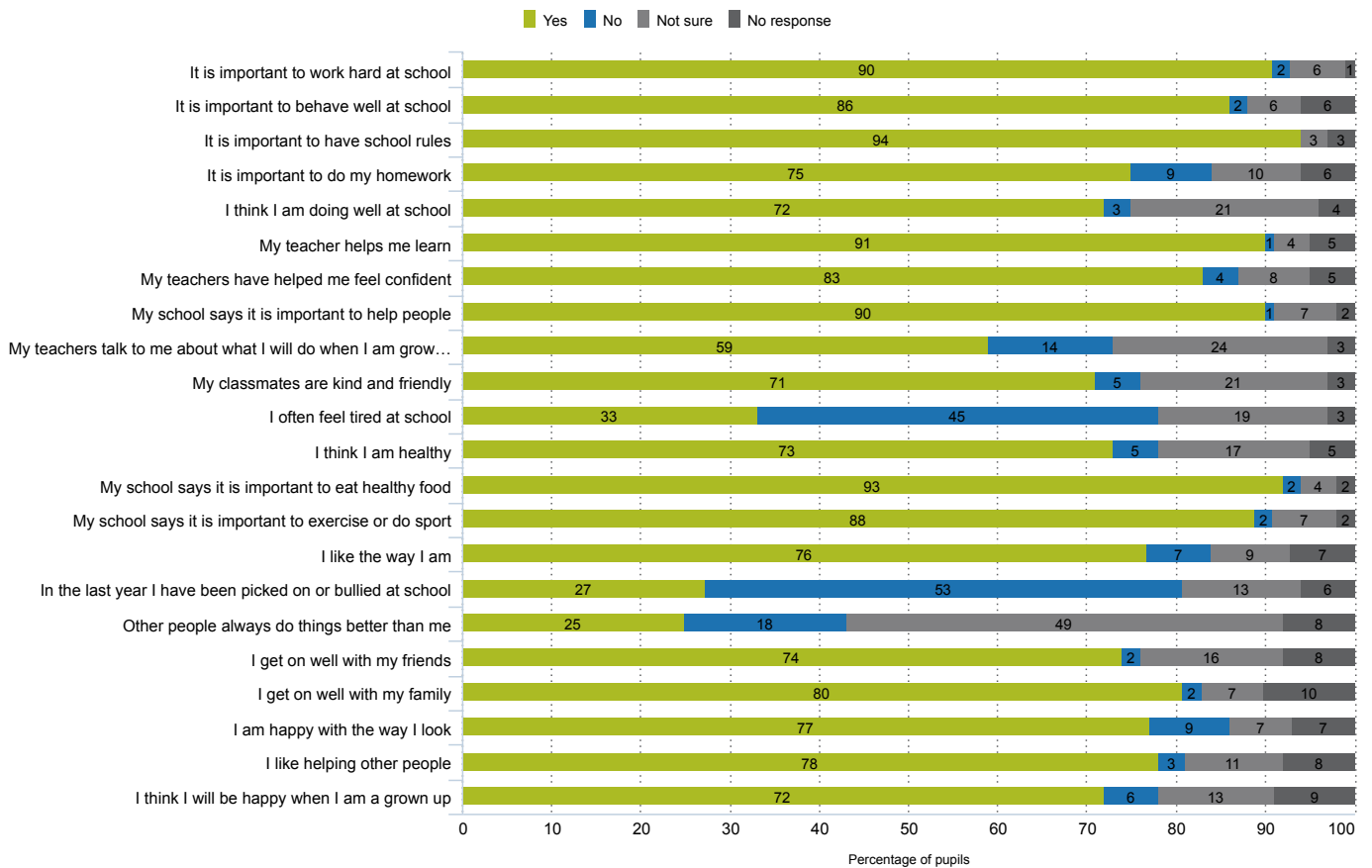
Key Findings 3 of 5 - Your school versus national overview chart

The chart below is sorted in descending order and shows the extent to which responses from pupils at your school are better or worse than responses from pupils in all schools. These are displayed in terms of t-values(1) so that roughly speaking any values above +2 indicate that responses are significantly better in your school and any values below -2 indicate that responses are significantly worse.



(1) A t-value is a statistical measure of the difference between two quantities. For the purposes of this chart they are truncated to be between -9 and +9.
