



For the financial year 2018-19, Hunslet Carr will receive **£19,310** in Sport Premium. The planned expenditure for this funding allocation is as follows:

Service Level Agreement with Active Schools- £1,000

The school will continue to sign up to the Active Schools service level agreement. It will allow us to continue to access professional advice and support to further develop the provision we provide for Physical Education, school sport and physical activity. The SLA allows us to access CPD and a wide range of school sport competitions and events.

Service Level Agreement with TSLA - £1,600

The school is wanting to continue links with the local high school and schools in the local cluster. Therefore, we are planning to sign up to a SLA once again. Schools within the cluster can compete in more competitions and have access to a wider range of sports via taster days.

Coaching - £5,075

To increase the amount of physical activity and range of activities available to all children during lunchtimes, we will be continuing to employ coaches to deliver lunchtime sessions. Pro Active will be running lunchtime clubs 5 times per week. The coaches will work alongside lunchtime staff, supporting their own delivery of lunchtime activities. These links will also encourage children to join their extra-curricular clubs. To improve school sport, Hunslet Club and The Ace Club will be running after school clubs.

Kit - £500

To continue to promote the importance of PE kit, we will be purchasing polo shirts for members of staff new to the school to ensure that they are modelling correct kit in PE lessons.



CPD - £2,000

To continue to promote high quality teaching and learning in PE, we will send new members of staff on training for REAL PE. Staff will also be attending CPD for school swimming. From this, teachers and teaching assistants can offer support to the swimming coaches, which allows for the children to be taught in smaller groups. As a result, this will improve the standards and outcomes of the school swimming programme.

Resources- £3,,000

The PE Subject Leader will audit and replenish the PE equipment and resources in school, in order to ensure that high quality teaching and learning can take place in PE lessons and after school clubs. In addition to this, an audit will take place in Early Years to ensure that the outdoor provision in Reception and Nursery challenges and supports the children's physical development.

Staff - £1,000

To ensure that children are able to access a wide range of competitive sporting events after school, we will continue to employ a member of staff to drive to all events.

PE coordinator - £2,500

To ensure the continued focus on PE, we will be paying the PE and Sport Coordinator a TLR. The PE coordinator will also be paid for additional hours to organise competitions, clubs and to complete actions on the action plan.

Swimming -£2,000

We will be looking into past assessments to establish the percentage of children who achieve 25m in Year 4. From this, we will investigate ways for children to catch up.
