Please ensure your child goes on this as much as possible.



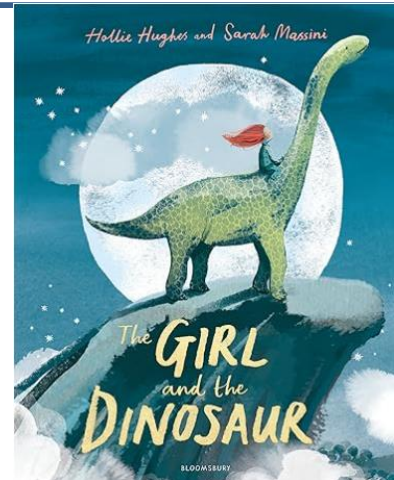
